This funding will be used to


- Guarantee that every student will either:
 - Achieve National Minimum Standards in Literacy and Numeracy for their year level or
 - Have an evidence based learning plan in place to address their specific learning needs.
- Ensure 100% of students in Years 3 and 5 who are not diagnosed with a learning disability or disorder are at or above the NAPLAN National Minimum Benchmark for reading.
- Every student accessing a different year level curriculum (that is, with an individual curriculum plan) will achieve a 'C' standard or better against the relevant year-level achievement standard.
- Support Year 1 students in 2015 to attain Regional (PM) Benchmarks and NAPLAN NMS in 2016 from 0% to 80%.
- 80% of students to achieve FNQ expectation of PM Level 9 by the end of Prep.

Our strategy will be to

- Increase teachers' repertoire of effective strategies for teaching text processing and comprehension across learning areas.
- Develop collaborative data inquiry processes (to build teachers' ability to interpret data, identify and scale-up effective teaching practices and differentiate better).
- Better prepare and support teacher aides to consolidate student learning in numeracy and literacy (including oral language and metalinguistic).
- Develop an Individual Learning Plan, diagnose learning difficulties and provide support for every student currently below NMS in literacy and numeracy.
- Improve reading, writing and numeracy resources for use in the classroom.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- **Human Resources** \$6,200
 - Delivery of Individual Speech Language Programs.
 - Pre prep program support.
 - Teacher Aide time allocation for intense intervention strategies with identified students.
 - Provide TRS to enable teachers to engage in collaborative data inquiry, action learning, classroom visits and professional conversations both internally and externally with other cluster schools.
- **Physical Resources** \$3,900
 - Replacing damaged or unusable PM Reader books.
